But while the center might be geared for finding your ancestors (the center's website includes tips for getting started in that area), the library does have a massive archival collection as well as rare books, papers of the St. Louis Fur Trade, and even records of antebellum Southern plantations.

Eight full-time staffers, plus part-timers and volunteers, are on hand to assist researchers.

"As far as the most-underutilized genealogy material at the Midwest Genealogy Center, I would say that the periodicals collection could be more used than it is," says Cheryl A. Lang, the center's manager. "Genealogy periodicals contain great amounts of research material and can seem difficult to use as there are not usually indexes available for periodicals. These materials are usually location or topic specific and require thorough searching to find family names. But periodicals are rich in genealogical material, [making them] very important resources."
