WWA HALL OF FAME CANDIDATES

Johnny Cash, Burt Kennedy, Frank Waters

Each year, one deceased writer is inducted into the Western Writers Hall of Fame. Nominees for induction in 2019, as chosen by a committee and approved by the Homestead Foundation board of directors, are songwriter Johnny Cash, screenwriter Burt Kennedy and historian/novelist Frank Waters.

WWA members may vote when election ballots are mailed next year. To be considered, the nominee must be dead for at least five years. Membership in WWA is not required.

The Western Writers Hall of Fame is housed at the Harold McCracken Research Library at the Buffalo Bill Center of the West in Cody, Wyoming.

Johnny Cash

(1932-2003)

One of the most iconic, popular and best-selling singer-songwriters of the 20th Century, Arkansas-born Johnny Cash often wrote about the American West and has been inducted into the Country Music, Rock and Roll and Gospel Music halls of fame.

A visionary, Cash recorded several concept albums, including *Ride This Train* (1960), *Bitter Tears: Ballads of the American Indian* (1964), *America: A 200-*



Year Tribute in Story and Song (1972) and *Sings Ballads of the True West* (1965), the latter partially inspired by his fascination with *True West* magazine.

Cash wrote Western songs such as “Don’t Take Your Guns to Town” (1958), “Apache Tears” (1964), “Big Foot” (1972) and “Angel and the Badman” (1991); appeared in several Western movies and TV shows; and even sang the theme song to the TV series *The Rebel*, created by Owen Wister Award recipient Andrew J. Fenady.

Burt Kennedy

(1922-2001)

Best remembered as the screenwriter for four of Randolph Scott’s acclaimed Western movies –

Seven Men From Now (1956), *The Tall T* (1956), *Ride Lonesome* (1959) and *Comanche Station* (1960) – Burt Kennedy was known for his wit and for creating complex scripts in



which the hero and villain typically respected one another.

Born in Michigan, Kennedy served in the Army during World War II and then settled in Hollywood, writing for the radio before John Wayne hired him as a screenwriter for Wayne’s production company. Kennedy later turned to directing films including *The*

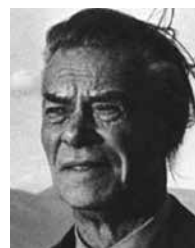
War Wagon (1967) and *Support Your Local Sheriff!* (1969).

Other screenplays include *The Rounders* (1965), *Welcome to Hard Times* (1967) and *White Hunter, Black Heart* (1990). He also wrote a memoir, *Hollywood Trail Boss: Behind the Scenes of the Wild, Wild Western*, published in 1997.

Frank Waters

(1902-2005)

Author of *The Man Who Killed the Deer*, first published in 1942 and still



in print, Frank Waters wrote 27 books, including novels, biographies, histories and collections of essays – most of his work reflecting his

interest in the Navajo, Hopi, Pueblo and pre-Columbian peoples.

Born in Colorado Springs, Colorado, the son of a part-Cheyenne Indian father and a mother from the antebellum South, Waters held miscellaneous jobs across the country, including managing editor at a Taos, New Mexico, newspaper and writer-in-residence at Colorado State University.

Other books include *Mexico Mystique: The Coming Sixth World of Consciousness*, *Midas of the Rockies*, *Book of the Hopi*, *Masked Gods: Navajo and Pueblo Ceremonialism* and *The Earp Brothers of Tombstone: The Story of Mrs. Virgil Earp*.
