Read at Home

Read at Home helping Indian preschoolers

SD Nelson, a Spur Award-winning author and illustrator of children's books, is serving as president of the nonprofit Read at Home, which seeks funding to provide material and training support to early childhood programs and schools that serve U.S. indigenous children ages 2-6.

"In my family, we always had monthly magazines coming to our home," said Nelson, an enrolled member of the Standing Rock Sioux Tribe in the Dakotas and a resident of Flagstaff, Arizona. "I was privileged to have parents who read books, magazines and newspapers at home.

"I have been in too many homes where Native children are not exposed to reading. When they get to first grade, they start out playing catch-up. Our Read at Home program provides the privilege of reading in the home at an early age."

The 501(c)(3) organization has provided magazines to more than 350 preschool children at Chinle/Canyon de Chelly, Many Farms and Tsaille (Navajo Nation, Arizona), subscriptions for 150 Head Start children at Fort Hall (Shoshone-Bannock Indian Reservation, Idaho), and has sent magazines to preschool classes at the Tuba City Library (Navajo Nation) and to the Gila River Indian Community in Arizona.
